Context	Persons with disabilities are overrepresented among people living in poverty, the percentage rate increases up to 20% (World Bank). In Kenya, estimates suggest that the prevalence of disabilities among children is 13.5% (VSO 2016). A research showed that overwhelmingly, children in rural areas had much higher disability rates (60%) than children in urban areas (40%). The total number of Speech and Language Therapists in the country is currently 16. This shows a huge need of Speech and Language Therapists.
Partner Organisation	Special Education Professionals (SEP) is a registered society with full-time staff and volunteers. SEP is a multi-disciplinary team of special education professionals working within the framework of education, rehabilitation and healthcare in Kenya. SEP works with children who have various conditions including cerebral palsy, autism, Down's syndrome, learning difficulties, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, mental challenges, developmental delay, communication disorder, hearing impairment, visual impairment amongst others. SEP is a Partner Organisation of COMUNDO since 2010.
Activities	As co-worker of COMUNDO you support primarily the therapists, interns and parents in the field of training. You plan and facilitate workshops on SLT (Speech and Language Therapy), you adapt the training contents to the beneficiaries and you draft handouts and manuals. In addition you will be part of the national SLT network and support the professional development of SLT in the country.
